BOARD ROOM RENOVATION RECOGNITION

Chris Hauge, School Facilities Engineer, stated that over the winter, the Board Room received a long overdue renovation and modernization. The improvements were the vision of the offices of the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent for Administration, Mrs. Chris Dayton, and Mrs. Nancy Harrington.

The scope of the improvements included new floor and window coverings, new lighting and controls, new ceiling systems, HVAC controls, and sound and technology systems in addition to renovating the rostrums for the Board of Education.

While limited parts of these improvements were contracted out, the vast bulk of the work was accomplished in house by Board of Education employees from Facilities, Information Technology, Custodial Operations, and Maintenance that performed all of the required work except for the floorcoverings and window treatments.
