What is the KRA? Will Your Child Be Ready for Kindergarten?

The Kindergarten Readiness Assessment measures both academic and non-academic domains to provide a comprehensive picture of a child's readiness. The KRA looks at readiness across four domains: **social foundations, language and literacy, math, and physical well being and motor development.**

Kindergarten readiness also means families are ready to encourage their child's learning and actively emphasize the importance of education.

Kindergarteners are assessed as:

- Demonstrating Readiness
- Approaching Readiness
- Emerging Readiness

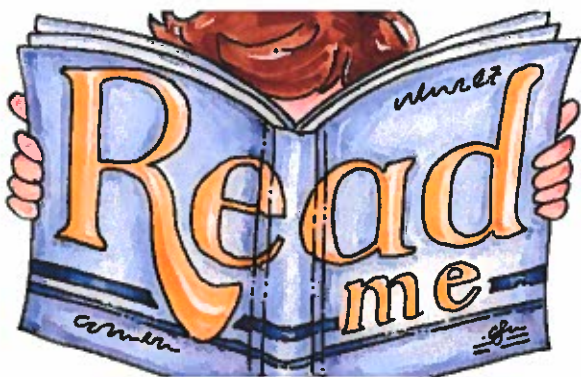

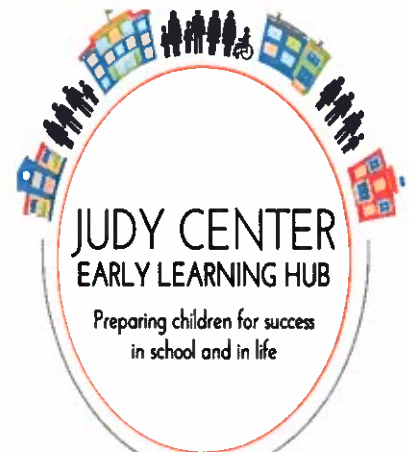
