Kenbre Skinner (left) and Branson McGraw (right) play a game of "Top It"; a math number game that reinforces number recognition and number comparisons.



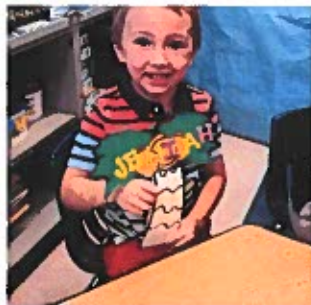

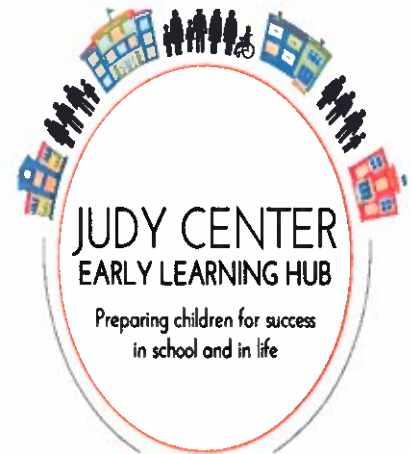
