2018 SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAMS

The Dorchester County Board of Education will be participating in the 2018 Summer Food Service Program at the following sites:

Choptank Elementary School, 1103 Maces Lane, Cambridge, MD 21613
Hurlock Elementary School, 301 Charles Street, Hurlock, Maryland 21643
Mace's Lane Middle School, 1101 Mace's Lane, Cambridge, MD 21613

The schools will operate as Open Sites starting on Monday, July 9, 2018 through Thursday, August 2, 2018.

Please note schools are **closed** on 7/4/18 and all Fridays). Meal times are Breakfast 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and lunch from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
