Collaborative Learning at Dorchester Career and Technology Center

Criminal Justice and Medical Services students recently collaborated at Dorchester Career and Technology Center to share their learning experiences. Criminal Justice students introduced the concept of fingerprinting and DNA collection that would assist law enforcement in the event of a missing child. The students worked in pairs and collected buccal swabs and fingerprints. Medical Services students demonstrated how to properly wash hands and practiced taking vitals, including pulse, respirations, and blood pressure.
