## North Dorchester High School Philadelphia Field Trip

Students studying U.S. history and government at North Dorchester High School as well as members of the school's History Adventurers Club visited historical sites in Philadelphia recently. Stops included the "birthplace of the nation" Independence Hall, the iconic Liberty Bell, and the National Constitution Center with its interactive exhibits and live theatre experience. Students also had the opportunity to have lunch at the historic Reading Terminal Market, now a food and cultural mecca of the city.

Field trips are a regular part of the Dorchester County Public Schools curriculum. When asked about the benefits of trips such as this, one said, "History is more easily understood when it can be interacted with . . . an experience that can usually only be had outside the classroom."
