## DCTC Students Help Forestry Board

AgriScience students at Dorchester Career and Technology Center helped the Dorchester County Forestry Board prepare 4,000 trees for the Backyard Buffer Tree Giveaway to be held on April 27, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Spocott Windmill.

The students, led by instructor Terry Nuwer, created bundles of spicebush, winterberry, baldcypress, river birch, and serviceberry trees that will be offered to the public at the event in celebration of Arbor Day. These varieties of trees are all native to Maryland and thrive in the wet environment of Dorchester County. They were grown in the John S. Ayton State Nursery in Preston.
