DCPS Participates in Maryland College Application Campaign

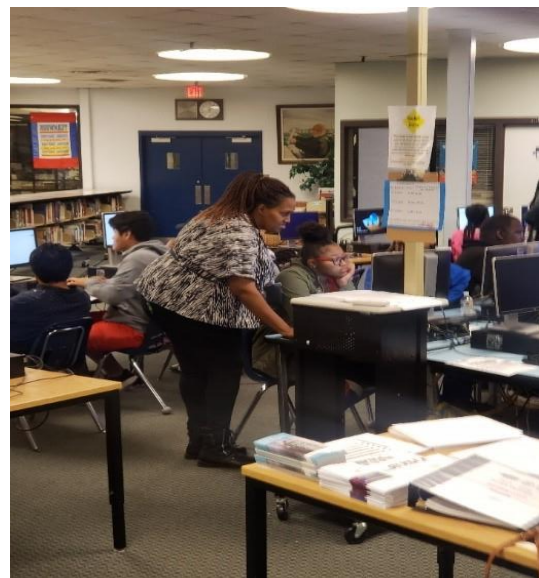
